Novice Division	under 9 years old as of January 1, 2019
Junior Division	9-12 years old as of January 1, 2019
Intermediate Division	13-15 years old as of January 1, 2019
Senior Division	16-18 years old as of January 1, 2019

Awards will be presented for Showmanship Divisions and Supreme Showmanship

#### Rules:

- 1. Rabbits must be checked in by 10:20am on Saturday, July 28th.
- 2. Judging will begin at 10:30am on Saturday, July 28th.
- 3. There can be no substitution of rabbits from those which were originally entered.
- 4. All rabbits must have tattoo in left ear.
- 5. Rabbits must be at least 8 weeks old to show.
- 6. Owners must provide watering equipment.
- 7. Rabbits will be divided into small class and large class.
- 8. Animals showing symptoms of disease must be removed from the grounds.
- 9. Only rabbits entered in the show will be allowed on the fairgrounds.
- 10. Show officials reserve the rights to make any changes deemed necessary.
- 11. The fair board, Madison County 4-H or volunteers will not be responsible for any loss of animals or equipment.
